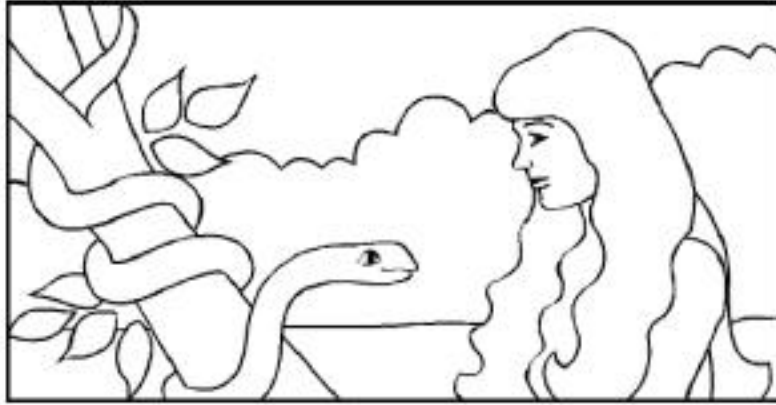


The Serpent's Lie
